THE FUTURE FOR BAGBY AIRFIELD

With no current restrictions over flight activity at the Airfield there are many routes that could be taken to maintain the commercial viability of it. We have chosen to add accommodation to the existing activities as we sincerely believe this will be less intrusive than any other form of commercial mitigation.

Indeed, we believed our previous proposal was also non-intrusive. However, we listened to concerns raised during the consultation and have slimmed down the proposals to what we consider is a balanced compromise. We tried to talk to representatives of Action4Refusal about the redesign but unfortunately they declined on the basis of 'legal advice'.

We have heard many stories about what is intended for the Airfield from various sources and we find many of them incredulous. Bagby Airfield will not become a thriving airport or a noisy hub of activity. We love the character of the Airfield as it stands and want to keep it that way.
