

# Bagby Airfield AGAIN

**This note is from Action 4 Refusal**, set up by some 300 local people, to stop commercial growth at Bagby Airfield destroying our peaceful lives, eroding our property values, threatening our safety and to returning Bagby airfield to a small private aero-club.

All residents who objected in 2008 succeeded in forcing Mr Scott, withdraw his application.

**Mr Scott has now reapplied for expansion.** An 18 bedroom hotel, restaurant and bar (no pool or gym now), 8 new hangers giving 3000 square meters of covered space and doubled area for aircraft maintenance and double the fuelling capacity.

You all know this will mean one thing to us, lots and lots more aircraft, helicopters, stunt planes, noise, growing to everyday of the week summer and winter.

**This is a new application and you must object again.**

Together we will stop Mr Scott ruining our lives.

## **Previous reasons of objection ..**

- (a) This is a quiet rural country open environment which will be threatened
- (b) Planning breaches of the past have not been addressed
- (c) The area is not designated for commercial development
- (d) This is unsustainable/unjustifiable, environmentally and as a business venture.
- (e) Inadequate information has been provided in terms of aircraft movements, noise and other commercial activity.
- (f) This is no Environmental impact assessment.
- (g) This development will inevitably lead to a large increase in air traffic it always has.
- (h) Noise of the planes and helicopters already bothers me, this will make it much worse.
- (i) This development contravenes Hambleton's own development policy; Bagby is outside the development limits.
- (j) The area is unsuitable for a hotel and commercial development, it is Green Belt.
- (k) It will kill off the local pub and hotels.
- (l) There are 4 other airfields in the area already providing the same service, Felixkirk, Baxtby, Topcliffe and Sutton

## **How to object**

1. You must write your own objections before February 24<sup>th</sup> 2009.

4. State clearly that you object
5. State your reasons
